Some thoughts & examples

Definitions

- RTV Silicone (room temperature vulcanization silicone) is a type of silicone rubber made from a two-component system (base plus curative; A+B).
- Resin Casting: a method of plastic casting where a mold is filled with a liquid synthetic resin, which then hardens (2 part-base plus catlyst).

Resin Casting Advantages

- Make small, not readily available parts
 - Odd prototype
 - Building corbels
 - Captures fine detail
- Stronger finish than 3D printing
 - 'layers' fused one pour
- Challenge & fun
 - Try something different

Disadvantages

• Relatively hi-cost

for materials vs output


- Limited shelf life
 - Resin ~ 6 mo
 - RTV ~ 12-18 mo








Rear Truck Side Frame






