### Message From The Superintendent

The NMRA convention and train show in St. Louis was a lot of fun. I had the pleasure of running a Soo Line engine with lots of help from the rest of the crew of Ray and Renee Grosser's layout. Ray's pass also got us into the show before the crowds arrived, which was very nice.

The National Trustees approved a dues increase to \$45.00 per year, which is slightly less than \$1.00 per month increase. I think it will be effective September 1, but don't quote me. I am sending in my renewal this month at the current rate for five years. This is like getting five years for the price of four. You might want to do the same.

There are a lot of changes being made to operate the NMRA more efficiently in the future. The Executive Director has resigned and will not be replaced at this time. The Convention chairman is gone as is past president Bob Charles from his fund raising position. A meeting is planned for MCR board members to meet with John Roberts, our new Executive Vice President, and Mike Brestel, our Trustee, to learn the facts about the budget deficit last year and action to prevent it in the future. It will be an interesting meeting with a lot of tough questions from the Div. Supers and Regional officers. A complete report will be made to you after the meeting.

Back to the fun of modeling at our Division level. This month we have an excellent clinic by Creston Parker from Div. 8 on how to build an advanced module with foam, a 5 foot home made foam cutter and other good tips. Don't miss it if you want to get up to speed on the advantages of building with foam vs hard shell. The tour will be Tom Brough's very nice HO layout.
