I was particularly impressed by how much progress had been made on the O scale layout since the first of the year. It is truly amassing how Ray and Renee work together to build such great railroads.

This month we will be visiting three model railroads in Danville, KY. Our first stop will be at Bob Lawson's. He will be providing a Bar-B-Q lunch from about 1:00 to 2:00. Bob's layout has just been photographed for its second appearance in Model Railroader (date, as of now, is unknown). Take your time visiting Bob's layout and enjoying a great meal. If you have not been to Bob's it is a very relaxing experience.

Next, you can go to either John Bowling's or Robin Grider's layout. Then, visit the other. A map to all three layouts is included elsewhere in this newsletter. All three of these locations offer something different for each of you.

John Bowling's layout, also to be featured in an upcoming edition of Model Railroader, is a HO model of the L&N in the late 50s'. It runs from Louisville through Eastern Kentucky encompassing all types of scenic surroundings. The layout is rich with museum quality dioramas depicting the working life of our state. Plan to spend a lot of time

viewing each scene as you will discover something new each time you look at it.

Robin Grider's HO layout is housed at the Danville Railroad Club. While there you will get a chance to meet some of the club members and watch as they pilot their trains over the hundreds of feet of track and the massive yard on Robin's layout. You will see locomotives and rolling stock from many railroads from the past and present located in Kentucky and the Eastern US as well as the Central and Western parts or our country.

Bob Lawson's HO Southern layout has been featured in Model Railroader a few years back and has been the focus of a volume of Allen Keller's "Great Model Railroads" video series. And, it is to be featured again in an upcoming issue of Model Railroader. Bob's layout features numerous scratch built structures and scenes from the 30's and 40's in the mid southern United States. You will see trains running through mountains, forests and urban areas, all built by Bob from his memory of what the country was like back then.

Don't miss this great afternoon of model railroading at its best. Plan to spend at least an hour at each layout plus plenty of time to enjoy lunch at Bob's. I will be looking for you!

In other club news, we are about at the halfway point with our HO raffle layout. The track and wiring are all done and we are coming along with the scenery. It should be finished by September when we will start selling raffle tickets. If you have any ideas how to increase ticket sales please let me know.


